Sun Tunnels - Solar and Tubular

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This Standard page and the items in the checklist below MUST be attached to your Modification Request Form to be accepted for review.

- Contractor proposal to include description and specifications of project/materials
- Photo of installation site
- Any permits needed by the city should be delivered to the Information Center prior to beginning the project.
- Picture/photo of sun tunnels to be installed

Standard

Solar Panels are prohibited from being installed on any exterior surface of any Avenbury residence.

Sun Tunnels/Solar Tubes

- There shall be a maximum of two (2) sun tunnel/solar tubes to be professionally installed per unit, a maximum of two domes per dwelling due to the size of the dome.
- If two are installed, they must be installed on separate surfaces (i.e. front and back) so that only one shall be visible from the street in front of the dwelling.
- The dome may have a diameter of 12" or 16".
- Tube design may be 10" or 14".
- Must be professionally installed.

Homeowner Responsibility

- Homeowner assumes all liability for installation, maintenance and repair.
- A copy of your complete Modification Request will be placed in resident's permanent file.
- Homeowner must contact Information Center when project is complete so a committee member can do a final inspection.
- Resident should keep a copy in their homeowner records.
