- As the weather allows, **Brightview** will cut down the ornamental grasses in homeowner and HOA mulch beds and brush hog the common meadow areas. Brightview began working on this task in January. They will also continue with mulch bed clean up throughout the winter whenever possible. Snow removal activities will be conducted when snow accumulation exceeds 2". 


