Outdoor Pool Lounging Policy

In accordance with the 2017 update to the Rules & Regulations, section U-19 permits residents to sit on the outdoor pool deck even when a lifeguard is not on duty.

The outdoor pool deck is open from the first Monday in May to the third Friday in October, (see Section U19 in the Avenbury Lakes Rules and Regulations). Pool deck access is only through the Lodge Activity Room, and only during Lodge open hours. Please stay out of the pool/spa water when no Lifeguard is on duty. Residents are permitted to sit on the pool deck when no Lifeguard is present and signs are posted in accordance with county and state regulations. All pool perimeter gates remain locked unless Lifeguard is on duty. All participants are to follow outdoor pool rules. No walking/sitting on pool/spa cover. Please close umbrellas when finished lounging and follow all Avenbury Lakes Rules & Regulations.



Community Manager Report

• Outdoor Pool: The last day of the 2022 Outdoor Pool season is Labor Day, September 5th. We hope you and your guests enjoyed the pool this year! <u>THANK YOU</u> to the Board of Directors, Patty Hales, the Brightview crew and the Hastings Lifeguards for a safe and successful year!!! <u>REMEMBER, YOU CAN STILL</u> <u>USE THE OUTDOOR POOL DECK FOR LOUNGING (NO SWIMMING)</u> <u>UNTIL OCTOBER 21st.</u>

• Brightview: Mowing continues. The pruning of new growth is taking place on shrubs in common and homeowner areas. Leaf cleanup will begin when leaves have fallen later in the year. Work will continue around the pond banks including cutting grasses and other plant materials and re-seeding selected areas as weather conditions permit. The third fertilization will occur in early September.

• **Roofing Project:** Final Touch completed 40 roofs on Nottingham and Buckingham this year. Thank you all for your patience during this extensive multi-year project.

• **Tree Care:** The Board contracted with Mikes Tree Service for routine maintenance in August. The cost of tree care: trimming, removal, storm damage, treating for diseases and other maladies, continues to increase each year as Avenbury Lakes and our heavily treed property get older. We will continue to manage this budget category in the most cost-effective manner possible.

• **Poison Ivy:** Please be aware of the three leaved ivy that grows on the ground and climbs up the trees when you are walking in natural areas. Poison Ivy turns red in the fall, a good warning to leave it alone!!!

• **Mailboxes:** Please note, new mailbox posts will be painted next year. The treated wood must cure for at least 6 months prior to painting.

• **New Maintenance Tech:** Please welcome Lynn Brada as the newest staff member to join Avenbury Lakes HOA. He has an extensive background as a retired Union carpenter and will be a great asset to the community.

Landscape Committee News

Summer is winding down and autumn is almost here. Some annuals are still beautiful with the cooler temperatures. Make note of what did well in your beds and think about replanting them next spring.

The garden centers have many beautiful fall flowers and perennials on display now. This is a great time to plant new perennials as the cool weather allows them to establish themselves before winter. It is also a good time to divide clumps of existing perennials. It's easier to divide them if you cut the stems to the ground. Transplanting them into healthy soil that has been



enriched with organic matter will allow them to thrive next year. This also helps to break up our clay packed soil.

Planting of spring blooming bulbs can be done in September or October.

It is still important to water the grass and trees if we have little rain. It's best to water in the morning to prevent disease.

Enjoy the rest of our nice weather. If the Landscape Committee can help in any way, don't hesitate to call the office or submit a landscape request.


