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AVENBURY LAKES ANNUAL MEETING & ELECTION 2023

Since our last two elections (2021 and 2022) were held by mail-in vote, and more residents responded than at an in-person meeting, the Board voted on January 26, 2023, at the Board Meeting to hold a mail-in-election and a Virtual Annual Meeting for 2023. The reason for the Virtual Annual Meeting is the increase in cost for the venue (high school auditorium), and the high cost of food. More information on the Virtual Annual Meeting will be in the April Breeze.

The Nominating Committee, consisting of R. Mazurak, Chair, M. Hirth, and G. Hawkinson, has been approved by the Board of Directors.

This year there will be one open seat on the Board.

~ Robert Mazurak's current term will end in April of 2023. He is not seeking re-election.

Residents who wish to serve on the Board are encouraged to run for this position. A letter of interest or intent along with a one-page biographical piece should be submitted to the Information Center by March 9, 2023. Qualifications to serve as a Board Member include being an owner of record and an association member in good standing (no delinquent assessments or outstanding rules violations). Candidate information and ballots, along with postage-paid envelopes for returning the ballots and an explanation of how we will maintain the secrecy of the votes will be mailed to all association members in good standing at least 35 days before the election results meeting.

On Monday, April 24, 2023, a three-member election committee, chosen by the Board, will verify and count the ballots. Then a special election results meeting will be conducted, via a video conference format that same day. Attendance at the election results meeting will be limited to a representative from our legal counsel, the Chairperson of the election committee, the candidates, the Community Manager, and the current

Board Members. The results will be announced at the Virtual Annual Meeting the next day, April 25, 2023, in the May BREEZE and on our website.

Beginning this month, **Ohio Geese Control** will be back on the property with their trained dogs gently hazing the geese into leaving the property. This is an important time of the year for this activity, discouraging them from feeling comfortable enough that they nest here later in the year.



- As the weather allows, **Brightview** will cut down the ornamental grasses in homeowner and HOA mulch beds and brush hog the common meadow areas. Brightview began working on this task in January. They will also continue with mulch bed clean up throughout the winter whenever possible. Snow removal activities will be conducted when snow accumulation exceeds 2". Winter is still with us, but we cannot forget that planning our gardens for the spring, summer and fall is something we can do while the snow flies. Once the threat of frost has passed and hopefully the sun has warmed the soil, we can start to think about the planting of any new perennials that will be arriving at our local nurseries. Of course, we cannot forget those beautiful annuals that add that needed pop of color in the late spring and early summer.

Here at Avenbury we have only our mulched areas that surround our homes to think about. We need to make sure that any perennials that we add to our gardens are on

the approved list. If in question, you can get in touch with any of the members of the Landscape Committee and they would be happy to provide you with assistance. The list of approved plants can be found on the website. If you find a perennial that you really like and believe it should be added to our list, please send us the information. We will look at that information and discuss the benefits of that cultivar. Much consideration is put into deciding if a plant is appropriate for the area/soil type/disease resistance.

All of us have some areas around our homes called common areas. Any plants that are put into these areas have to be done with a recommendation from the Landscape Committee and the approval of the Board of Directors. The work is then turned over to Brightview our landscape contractors. These areas cannot be planted by the residents. We do want your help to identify any area that needs work. We can evaluate it and put it on a list. It is then decided by the Committee which area is in most need. Of course, we all know that the budget only goes so far and not all areas can be done in one season.

We look forward to another year of growing. Please help us by sending all your requests on the proper forms that can be found on the website or can be obtained at the Information Center. For your information, the LC meets once a month and it can take 4-6 weeks for your request to be processed. The LC thanks you for your patience and your concern for our community.
