

What Does The Community Fund Do?

Since its inception in 2006, the Community Fund has provided funding for many projects that benefit all residents of Avenbury Lakes.

The Community Fund funded the materials to light our three bridges so that they glow at night, making our community warm and inviting, as well as providing lighted walkways. It also sponsors the summer concerts at the pool and the hot dog cookouts, as well as paying for the license for the movies that are sometimes shown on Sunday evenings in the winter months.

Other projects include:

- The art gallery system in the lodge
- A warming oven for the lodge kitchen
- Bistro tables and stacking chairs for the pool area
- Rockers and tables for the lodge porch and pool area
- Large screen TV in the all-purpose room
- TV sets in the exercise room
- Trio of planters and annuals to brighten the pool area
- Landscape improvements at the pool and the front of the lodge
- Landscape improvements along Middleton and Shakespeare
- Bookshelves, shutters and closet renovations at the lodge
- The Avenbury Lakes signs at both ends of Middleton
- The original paver garden that turned into a fundraiser and continues to grow

How Does the Community Fund Receive Its Funding?

Our funding comes mainly from donations in memoriam or in appreciation for services provided by "Neighbor Helping Neighbor", the Landscape Committee or others in the community.

Other sources of funding are the purchase of engraved pavers for our paver garden and fundraisers such as the Avenbury Home Tour, the 50/50 raffle and the hot dog cookouts at the pool.
