Standard

Must be professionally installed

Installation of an emergency standby Whole House Generator System is subject to the following conditions:

- Installation in Compliance with the Ohio Revised Code.
- It is contained totally within the three-foot area surrounding the home and, if not in the mulched area, the owner is responsible for trimming the grass around the installation.
- Installed by licensed tradesmen, i.e., electrician, plumber etc.
- The homeowner provides written statements signed by close neighbors that it will not be a nuisance to them.
- Depending on the placement of the generator in relation to the gas line hook-up, any wiring or piping running from unit to soffit entering attic must be covered by a white metal/vinyl enclosure approximately three inches X four inches. Seal by applying putty or pliable caulking to the bottom of the enclosure.

Auxiliary Portable Generators

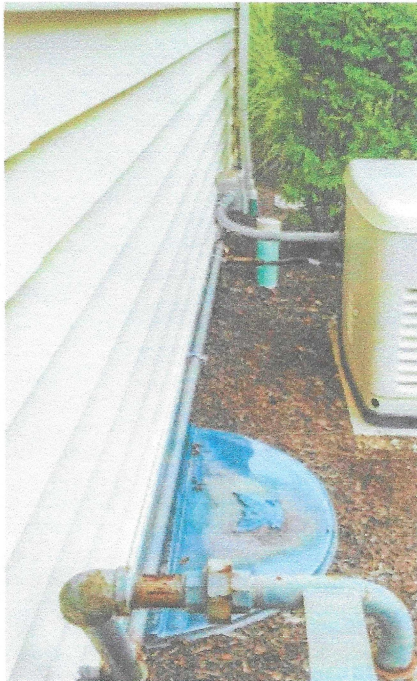
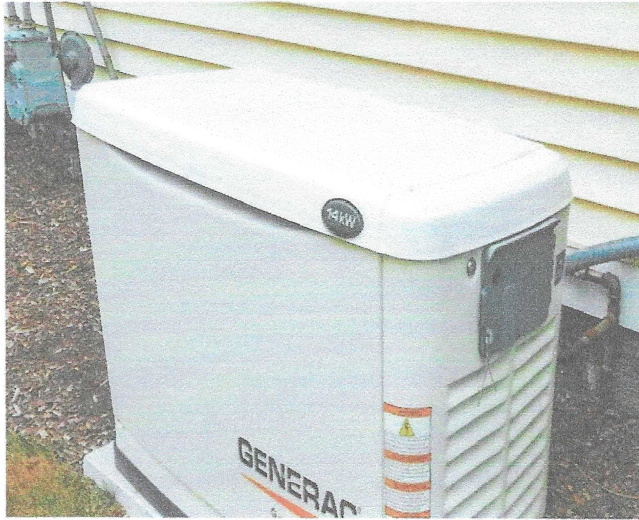
This option is for those who need emergency power because of health issues or basement sump pumps. The generator would be run to the appliance with an outdoor extension cord.

Homeowner Responsibility

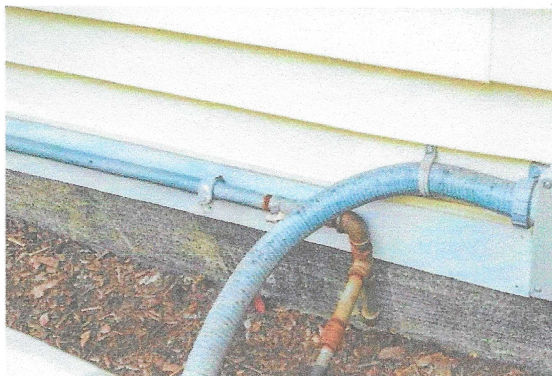
- Homeowner assumes all liability for installation, maintenance, and repair.
- A copy of your complete Modification Request will be placed in resident's permanent file.
- Homeowner must contact Information Center when project is complete so a committee member can do a final inspection.
- Resident should keep a copy in their homeowner records.

Generator Installation - Any wiring or piping running from unit to soffit entering attic must be covered by a white metal/vinyl enclosure approximately three inches X four inches. Seal by applying putty or pliable caulking to the bottom of the enclosure.
