Summer Concert Cookouts


The Community Fund is happy to announce that there will be Hot Dog Cookouts one hour prior to the start of the concerts.

From the Community Manager... Ruth Angell

Pool Season: As you may know, the pool season opening has been delayed, due to unforeseen circumstances. We look forward to the pool grand opening in June and will keep residents appraised of any new information. We thank you for your patience and understanding during the pool restoration project!

Private Owner Gardens: If you are not aware, Brightview Landscaping will prune shrubs up to approximately 5' only. If shrubs and trees located in your private gardens have outgrown the space, please consider landscaping options. Before removing or installing new plantings, please submit your request to modify your garden by completing a Landscaping Modification Form.

Tree Limb / Yard Debris: We appreciate residents taking time to remove debris from your gardens. Some residents go above and beyond, removing tree limbs, both small and large, from their yards and common areas as well. We encourage residents to purchase yard debris bags from your local store and hardware stores.

We do ask residents to place all yard debris & tree limbs in yard bags and place them out for a scheduled pick up by the City of Avon free of charge. When piles of debris are left in common areas and near the street curbside or near wood lines, the removal of these piles comes at a cost to all residents as the Board must contract with Brightview Landscaping to remove the piles of debris from time to time. Please note this is a service beyond their contract and the piles impeded on their efforts to mow properly.

Trash Rules Reminder: This is a gentle reminder that trash cans and recycle bins should not be placed outside before dusk, the day before a scheduled pickup. This is important to remember, particularly around Holidays. Residents will be notified of any known changes to the refuse schedule in advance when possible.

Landscape Committee News

Summer is here and we should have most, if not all, our perennials and annuals planted. May was an unusual month. We had both warm and humid and cool and dry. That would make May a great growing month due to all the rain. June is here and we enjoy the growth in our plants from those conditions. Just remember the weather will get hot and humid once again and watering will become a very necessary chore. All common areas around your home need to be watered also, as we asked in the May Breeze. This will help to keep our community green and lush.



There's still time to plant those annuals and add some vegetables to the garden. Pots on the patio do well if kept watered and receive the sunlight needed. At the end of summer you will be enjoying those tomatoes and peppers that you have grown yourself.

Just a few reminders from the Landscape Committee and the Board of Directors:

- Here are the steps to follow for any plans you may have for a landscape change:
 - If you plan to replace three or more shrubs or remove or plant a tree, you must submit a Landscape Modification Form.
 - 2. Submit a drawing of the layout and exactly what plants and how many would be planted with the Landscape Modification Form.
 - 3. Submit the name of the Landscaper
 - 4. Make sure all the plants are on the Avenbury Plant List.
 - 5. You must have approval from the Landscape Committee before any work can be done.
 - 6. Please allow 4-6 weeks for your request to be approve.
- There have been concerns about mowing. If we have rain the mowing may be delayed. This is done to protect the
 turf areas. This is left to the discretion of Brightview. Please be patient and the mowing will return to its regular
 schedule as conditions dictate.
- If mulch is piled around the base of your tree, please remove it carefully. If you have any questions about this, the office or the member the Landscape Committee will be glad to help.
- If you do not want Brightview to prune your plants you <u>must</u> submit a NO Prune Form every year to the Office. This way you will be put on a list. Forms are available on the Avenbury Lakes website.

Enjoy this beautiful time of year and know that the Office or the Landscape Committee is available to answer questions.






