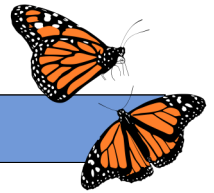

Kentucky Derby Party

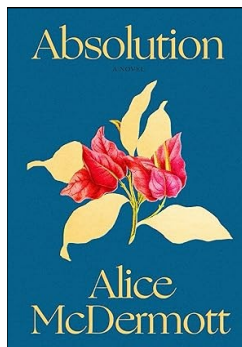

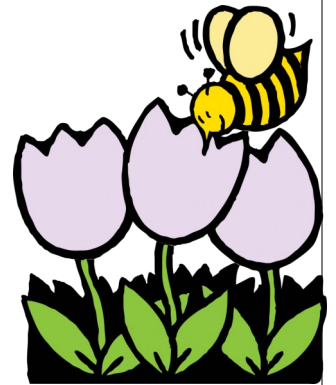

Landscape Committee News

May and all those jobs in the yards and gardens need to be accomplished. Daffodils and hyacinths and other spring bulb plants need to have the foliage dry out before removing it. Depending on the weather this can take a month. In the meantime, we have to work around them and let the drying happen naturally. If not, and the leaves are removed too soon, you will lose some flowering next year, so please be patient. The leaves are the food for next year's flowers.

There is still time to fertilize your gardens with an all purpose slow release fertilizer. Our winter was harsh with rain and snow. The soil is depleted and in need of nutrients. As always when you plant anything new in your yard remember to add fertilizer to the planting hole and mix well. Mixed with the soil, it will help your plants grow strong root systems and stay healthy during the long hot summer.

Once the danger of frost has passed, the annuals can be planted. This usually starts in the third or fourth week of May. It is so important to keep an eye on the weather report to be sure. Let the temperatures and the soil be your guide. If the soil feels cold to the touch, it is probably not a good idea to plant those tender annuals. Starting now your shrubs and perennials are in need of frequent watering. This will keep them lush and looking healthy. New growth must be watched for the emergence of insects and our local animals munching on those fresh leaves and roots. Inspect your garden regularly to keep those critters under control.

If you have plants that have been destroyed by the cold and snow remove them and use our extensive plant list to replace them. If you wish to do more than replace three shrubs, please fill out a Landscape Request form asap and it will be reviewed by the LC and sent to the BOD with our recommendation, if needed. When in doubt feel free to contact a member of the Landscape Committee and we will help you. Remember all trees in the mulched area have to be approved by the BOD before planting.

Landscape Reminders:

- 1.) Mulch will NOT be provided by the community. If done by the Homeowners, it must be brown in color and triple shredded.
- 2.) Watering is of extreme importance if we don't have adequate rain. Please water the common areas around your home. This will help to ensure that the turf grasses look green and healthy.
- 3.) The Landscape Committee is holding a question and answer meeting on Tuesday May 19, 2026 at 2:00 PM in the Lodge. All in the Avenbury Community are invited. Please bring your Landscape questions. We look forward to seeing you!



The Outdoor Pool Opens Saturday, May 23- Weather Permitting!

The hours will be the same as last year: Sunday, Monday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday from 12:00 - 6:00 pm and Tuesday, Thursday from 2:00 - 8:00 pm.



OUTDOOR POOL GUEST PASSES: The pool is open to guests (up to 6 guests per household, per visit). *Residents need to purchase a Guest Pass from the Lodge Administrator PRIOR to May 23, 2026 **PASSES WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE AT THE OUTDOOR POOL. YOU MUST PURCHASE PASSES AHEAD OF YOUR VISIT.** The pass includes 11 visits for \$20. Residents do not need a pass, only their guests.

All residents **MUST SIGN** the Pool Agreement so that they understand the rules prior to using the pool. **Please sign the form enclosed in the Breeze and drop it off at the Lodge in the marked box.** There will be extra forms available at the Lodge. All signed Agreements will be retained as proof that each resident agrees to abide by the rules.

As a reminder, the rules will be posted on a large sign near the entry gate and also near the door to the restrooms. A table on the Outdoor Pool deck will have a daily Attendance Sheet that needs TO BE SIGNED by each resident and guest using the pool that day. Thank you in advance for your cooperation!

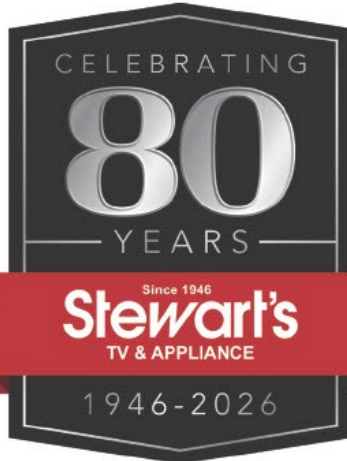

How to Order Avenbury Lakes Merchandise

You must set up your own account on the Lands End Business Outfitters site as follows: Go to **landsend.com** and click on **Business Outfitters** in the upper right corner of the website. There is verbiage that, even if you have a Lands End account, you will have to set up a separate account on Business Outfitters. To do so, click on **Continue**, then go to **Sign In** at the top right, set up your user name and password. **Log into your new account** then click on **your name to go to your account profile to update your information**. Click on **My Logos**, then click on **Associate a Logo to My Account**. Add the **Logo 1358729** and then add the **Customer Number 6416148**. You should be able to browse the Lands End Outfitters catalog and place your own orders. If you add the logo, the added cost is usually \$6.95, but is subject to change. If you have any questions or need help setting up your account or ordering hats or tote bags, do not hesitate to call Lands End Customer Service 800-587-1541.



Reminder for Sign-up and Payment Procedures for Social Events

- New sign-up sheets will be placed in the Activity Book on the first weekday of each month.
- Sign one name per line; couples are not to be listed on a single line.
- Payment for an event is required at the time you sign up. Your payment holds your reservation. There will be a cut-off date for receiving payment for each event, and there will also be a two-week cut-off before the event for refunds if you are unable to attend.
- The committee will NOT call each resident if payment is not received by the cut-off date. Your name will be deleted from the list.
- When the maximum number of spaces has been filled, the names are entered on the waitlist on the sign-up sheet for the event. Do not pay if you are on the wait list unless you are called by a member of the committee notifying you that there is an opening.
- Payments can be made by cash or check. Place cash in an envelope marked with your name and the event for which payment is made. If paying by check, write the event's name on the memo line and put the check in the box on the desk. An envelope is not necessary for a check.
- All checks are to be made payable to ALHOA.
- A separate payment is required for each event. No post-dated checks will be accepted.
