

## 2026 Pool Schedules

### OUTDOOR:

Open: Saturday, May 23<sup>rd</sup> through Monday, September 7<sup>th</sup>

Days/Hours:	Monday/Wed/Fri/Sat/Sun	12:00pm- 6:00 pm
	Tues/Thurs	2:00 pm- 8:00 pm

#### **Notes:**

- The first hour of every day is for residents only
- Children (under 18) may swim every day from the 2<sup>nd</sup> hour through the 5<sup>th</sup> hour
- Adult guests may swim every day from the 2<sup>nd</sup> hour through closing
- There is no adult guest fee for those who arrive to swim for only the final hour on any day

#### **Breaks:**

##### **Monday/Wed/Fri/Sat/Sun**

- 1:45-2:00 pm: All swimmers must exit
- 2:45-3:00 pm: Children only must exit
- 3:45-4:00 pm: All swimmers must exit
- 5:00 pm: All children must leave pool area
- 6:00 pm: All swimmers must leave pool area; pool closes

##### **Tues/Thurs**

- 3:45-4:00 pm: All swimmers must exit
- 4:45-5:00 pm: Children only must exit
- 5:45-6:00 pm: All swimmers must exit
- 7:00 pm- Children must leave pool area
- 8:00 pm: All swimmers must leave pool area; pool closes

### INDOOR:

Day/Hours: Generally open during Lodge hours of operation

Monday/Tues/Wed/Thurs	9:00 am- 9:00 pm
Fri/Sat	9:00 am- 8:00 pm
Sun:	12:00 pm- 8:00 pm

Notes: Please see scheduled posted on the wall near pool entry doors for specific class times & guest hours.

## OUTDOOR POOL

- The lifeguard has the final say on rule clarifications.
- The outdoor air temperature must be 70 degrees for the pool to open.
- The lifeguard may close the outdoor pool during threatening weather.
- The outdoor pool must have a lifeguard on duty for the safety of all swimmers.
- When no lifeguard is on duty, no one is allowed in the water (pool or spa).
- Scheduled breaks for adults and children are required at stipulated time periods.
- The lifeguard will blow a whistle two times to signal that either children or **all** swimmers must exit the pool. A whistle will be blown once when swimmers may re-enter the pool.
- Children are not permitted to go from the outdoor into the indoor pool area during the 15 minute break.
- Children under 18 years old are not permitted in the bar stool area.
- The spa must also be vacated during breaks.
- No standing or jumping from the pool bar top, seats, ledge or anywhere around the hot tub is permitted.
- Pre-paid guest passes are available from the Lodge Administrator in blocks of 11 visits/season for \$20 each. Unused visits do not carry over to the next season and refunds are given on pre-paid cards. Children under 2 years of age may enter free.
- Lifeguards cannot accept any money or collect fees.
- During crowded swim times guests may bring their own lawn chairs.
- Residents must sign in when entering the pool area.
- **No bicycles are permitted anywhere inside the pool deck area-07-11-.24\*\***
- **All areas in and around the Lodge including the pool, pool deck, all entrances, all bridges, are no smoking/no vaping zones.**

## INDOOR & OUTDOOR POOLS

- It is recommended that residents not swim alone in the indoor pool.
- Guests must be accompanied by a resident at all times.
- There is a maximum of 6 guests daily per unit.
- Residents are responsible for the actions of their guests.
- All swimmers must shower before entering a pool or spa
- **Residents and guests in wet bathing suits may not enter the Lodge. Wet bathing suits are limited to the locker rooms only.**
- Use of flotation aids may be limited according to the pool conditions and crowds.
- Cut-off jeans are not permitted in either pools or spas.
- People wishing to listen to any electronic device must use headphones.
- No plug-in devices are allowed in the pool area; battery operated devices only.
- No pets are permitted in the pool area.
- Glass containers and gum are not permitted in or around either pool or spa.
- No item less than 4" square and 4" in diameter are to be used in the pool area.
- No running on the pool deck areas.
- Babies **MUST** wear swimming diapers when in the pool.
- Wet and dirty diapers need to be taken back home and **not** disposed of in the locker room, indoor pool area, or any other trash container on the property.
- The hot tubs/spas are for **adults (18 years & up) only.**
- Only authorized personnel are allowed in the pool mechanical rooms.

## HOT TUBS

- **ADULTS 18 YEARS OF AGE AND OVER ONLY!**
- Do not use water temperatures greater than 104°F.
- Do not use alone.
- Observe reasonable time limits: 10-15 minutes max at a time; less if you are pregnant or are suffering from heart disease, diabetes, or high or low blood pressure.
- Long exposure may result in nausea, dizziness, or fainting.
- Do not use the hot tub/spa while under the influence of alcohol, tranquilizers, or other drugs that cause drowsiness or that raise or lower blood pressure.
