Important Reminder – Pool Agreement Required!

All residents must sign the Pool Agreement before using the Outdoor Pool. This ensures everyone understands and agrees to follow the pool rules.

If you have not yet completed your form, please sign and return it to the front desk at the Lodge as soon as possible. Extra forms are available at the Lodge if needed.

Pool rules are posted near the entry gate and restroom area for easy reference. In addition, all residents and guests using the pool are asked to sign the daily Attendance Sheet located on the pool deck during each visit.

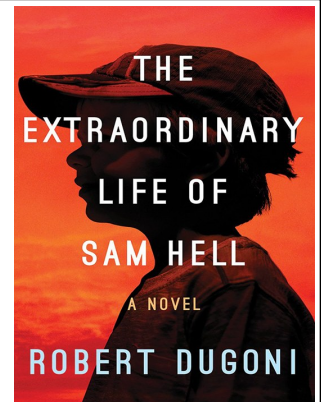

A Message from the Landscaping Committee...

Summer is finally here. We can take joy in the flowers in bloom and the trees with their bright green leaves. Garden centers are full of beautiful annuals and vegetable plants just waiting to be planted in someone's yard.

It is now safe to plant all those annuals with their many different shapes and colors. Just make sure you choose plants that are suited for the sunny and shady areas in your landscape. We can also enjoy some of the tropical plants being offered in colors we do not often see in this region. The garden centers are full of them.

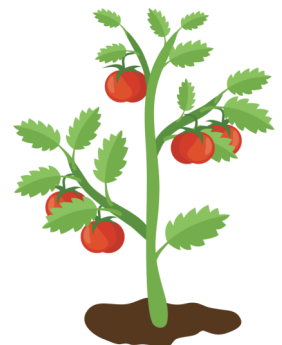
Vegetable plants are plentiful. A tomato plant in a pot on the patio will yield enough tomatoes for you to enjoy during the latter part of the summer. We have found that the Better Boy variety, as well as specialty-bred patio tomatoes, do well in patio conditions. Have fun and experiment with some herbs in pots. They will add flavor to all your favorite recipes.

Watering becomes especially important at this time of year, particularly for plants growing in pots, as they tend to dry out more quickly. It is also necessary to feed them with a water-soluble fertilizer during the growing season. Check them every day, and when temperatures rise, they should be checked twice a day.

If you plan to plant more than three shrubs or plant a tree, you must submit a Landscape Modification Form to the Information Office. The request will then be evaluated by the Landscape Committee. At this time, all requests for trees must also be sent to the Board of Directors for approval. No work may be performed until approval has been received by the resident.

Enjoy this month of June, because most plants are at their best and will continue to give you a great deal of pleasure if you care for them properly.

Take time to enjoy yourself, and stay safe and well.

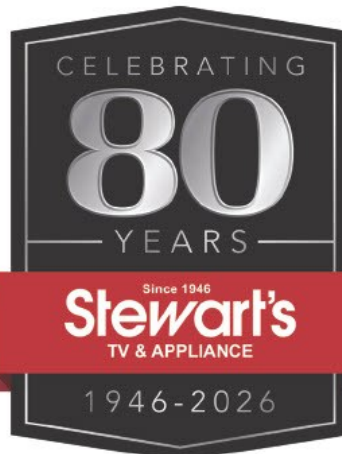

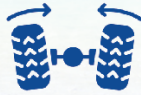
