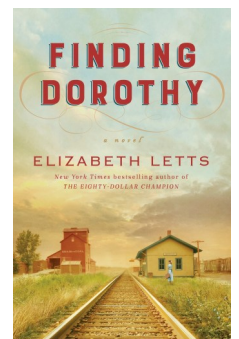

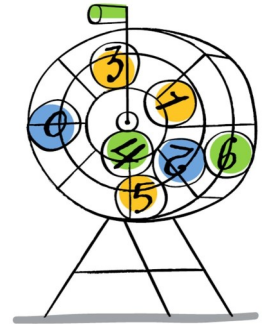
The Avenbury Lakes Quilt Club will meet at 1:00 p.m. on Thursdays, July 2nd and 16th in the Lodge.

FLAG DETAIL SEEKING VOLUNTEERS

The Avenbury Lakes Flag Detail has the honor and privilege of raising and lowering the American flag on the flagpole near the front entrance to our Lodge.

The three current members of the Flag Detail have handled this responsibility for many years. However, as all the members of the Flag Detail are now in their eighties, it has become more difficult for them to handle this responsibility in a safe manner under all types of weather conditions. We recently welcomed a new volunteer to the Flag Detail—Don Blue. Thank you, Don!

If any resident of Avenbury Lakes is interested in serving on the Flag Detail or has questions pertaining to what would be expected of them, please contact Al Pina at 440-610-3313 or Bob Sexton at 440-670-5145.

You do not need to be a military veteran to serve on the Flag Detail. Any resident, male or female, can serve on the Flag Detail. Proper instructions on how to raise and lower the flag and additional flag etiquette will be provided to all volunteers.

The flag is raised and lowered per an assigned schedule each year and removed from the flagpole when wind gusts exceed 40 mph. The flag can also be flown at half-staff at other times as approved by our Board of Directors.

Thank you for your consideration, and we would greatly appreciate your assistance and involvement in honoring our flag and those who have served and continue to serve our great country.

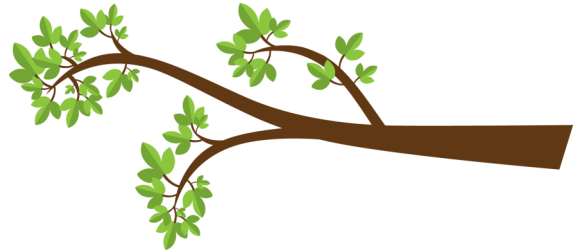


Disposal of Tree Limbs and Shrubs

The City of Avon provides free curbside chipping services for branches, limbs, and shrubs. **This service only applies to homes located on Pembroke and Nottingham.** To utilize this service, residents must contact the Avon Service Department at 440-937-5729 or submit an online curbside chipping request to be added to the pickup list.

Preparation Requirements:

- Place branches in one direction on the tree lawn.
- Do not tie or bundle branches.
- Branches must be 6 inches in diameter or less.
- Shrubs are accepted.
- No root balls.
- No tall ornamental grasses.
- No debris mixed into the pile.
- No yard waste generated by professional contractors.



Pickup Timing:

- Crews generally complete the route within one week.
- Following major storms or periods of heavy damage, collection may take up to two weeks.

Residents on streets not serviced by the City are responsible for arranging the disposal of tree limbs, branches, shrubs, and other yard waste. BrightView does not provide pickup or disposal services for homeowner-generated yard waste. Republic Services will collect small bundles of branches as part of regular trash service. Branches must be:

- Cut into lengths of 4 feet or less.
- Securely tied into bundles.
- No more than 35 pounds per bundle.

IMPORTANT: Do not dispose of limbs, branches, shrubs, grass clippings, or other yard waste in common areas, wetlands, retention areas, or natural open-space areas.



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Avenbury Lakes Homeowner

Home prices in Avenbury Lakes vary greatly depending on:

- Which floorplan, how many square feet, # of bedrooms, if there's a basement and if it's finished.
- Optional features when the house was built, such as sunroom, patio, fireplace, bay windows, irrigation system.

- Updates to the big ticket items such as furnace, AC, flooring, appliances, kitchen/bathroom cabinets & counters, shower/tub, paint, light fixtures, doors. *Even if your home hasn't been updated, it can still sell successfully when priced appropriately for its condition.*

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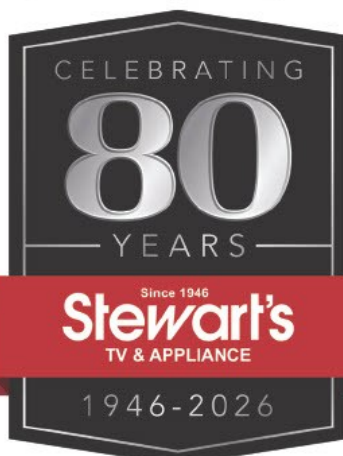
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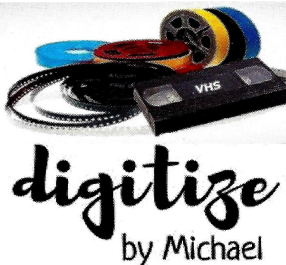
