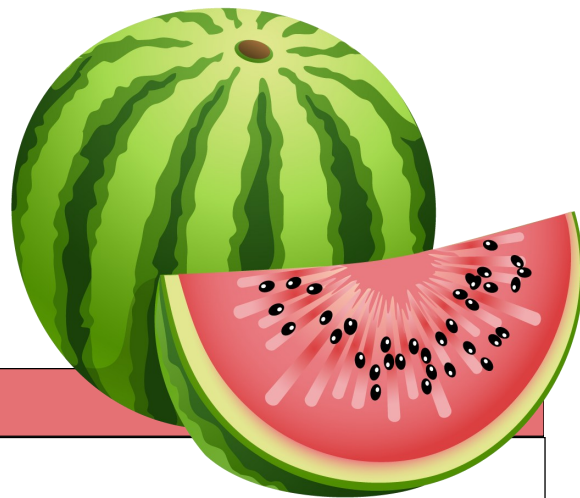

Both events begin at **10:00 a.m.** We hope you'll join us for a relaxing morning of conversation, refreshments, and community!

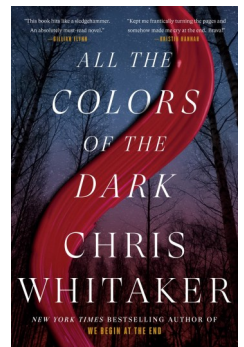
And A Big Thank You to Our Coffee Volunteers!

The American Heart Association Heartsaver CPR AED course is designed for individuals with little or no medical training who need CPR and AED certification for employment, regulatory, or other requirements. Participants will learn how to recognize cardiac emergencies, perform high-quality CPR, and safely and effectively use an Automated External Defibrillator (AED).

This **FREE** class will be held on **September 21 from 5:00–7:30 PM** in the Activity Room at the Lodge. Please arrive 15 minutes early to complete registration before the class begins. Sign up in the Activity Book located at the Lodge.

Official AHA course completion cards are \$25. Participants may also choose to receive a **free PDF certificate** instead. The official AHA card is typically required for those who need CPR certification for employment or other official purposes.

Admission is free, but attendees are encouraged to bring a donation of needed items for CRS. Registration begins **September 1**, so be sure to sign up early to reserve your spot.



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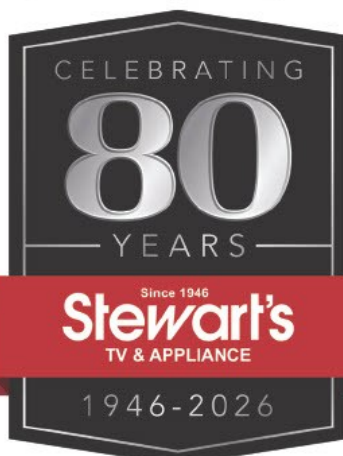
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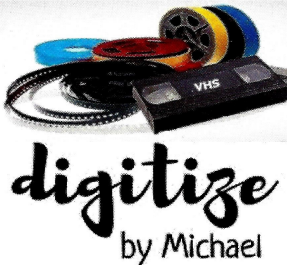
