Fall Gardening Notes from the Landscaping Committee

September is a month of transition. We move from the hot days of August into the cooler days of early fall. The annuals in our gardens are still beautiful and often thrive in the cooler temperatures. However, they still need to be watered, although not as frequently as they did in August.

To bring some new color to your fall garden, don't forget the chrysanthemums, or mums! They are plentiful and available in many beautiful colors at garden centers and farm markets. Mums are easy to plant in your garden. They prefer full sun, rich, well-drained soil, and consistent watering because they have a relatively shallow root system.

An even easier option is to buy mums already potted and simply place them around your garden or yard. They are available in many sizes, from small 6-inch pots all the way up to large 20-inch pots. With so many colors and sizes to choose from, mums can add a wonderful splash of fall color to your landscape.

September is also the time to begin thinking about next spring's garden. Start planning now and plant your spring-flowering bulbs, such as tulips, daffodils, and many other colorful early bloomers. With a little preparation this fall, you'll be rewarded with a beautiful garden when spring arrives!

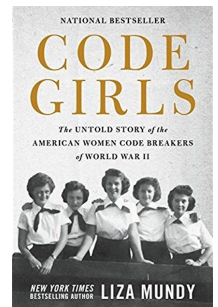


For just **\$4**, come enjoy a relaxing morning together and help us wrap up another great season. We hope to see you there!

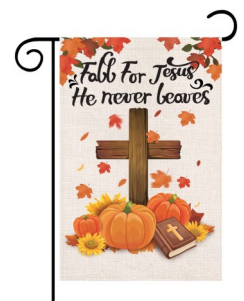

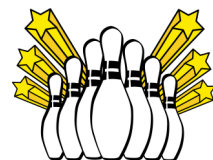

September Flag Observances at Avenbury Lakes

The flag in front of the Avenbury Lakes HOA Lodge will be lowered to half-staff at 8:00 a.m. and returned to full-staff at 6:00 p.m. on September 11, in honor and remembrance of the 2,977 people who lost their lives in the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001, as well as the 441 first responders who died while responding to the attacks and attempting to save those in need.

POW/MIA Recognition Day

On the third Friday of every September, we observe POW/MIA Recognition Day. This year, it falls on September 18. On this day, we honor the more than 80,000 American service members who remain unaccounted for from past conflicts, including those who were prisoners of war, killed in action, or whose remains have not yet been recovered and identified.

The POW/MIA Flag symbolizes our continued remembrance and support for American service members who served our country, particularly those who were captured, remain missing, or never returned home.

On September 18, the POW/MIA Flag will be affixed beneath the United States Flag. Both flags will be flown at full-staff from 8:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.

Please stand with us on these two important days, during the hours indicated, as we honor and remember those who made the ultimate sacrifice and those who remain missing.

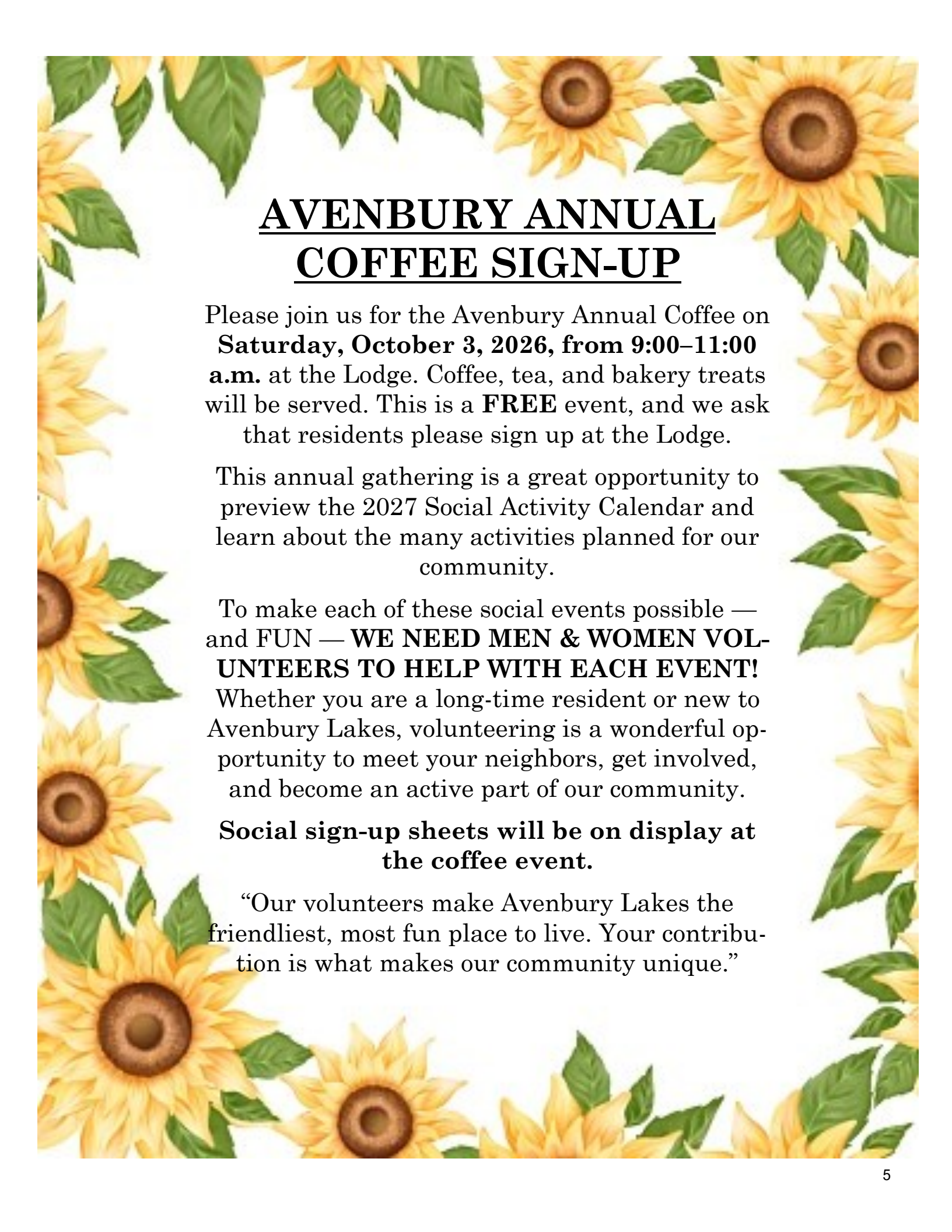
Ping Pong at the Lodge

Indoor Pool Hours

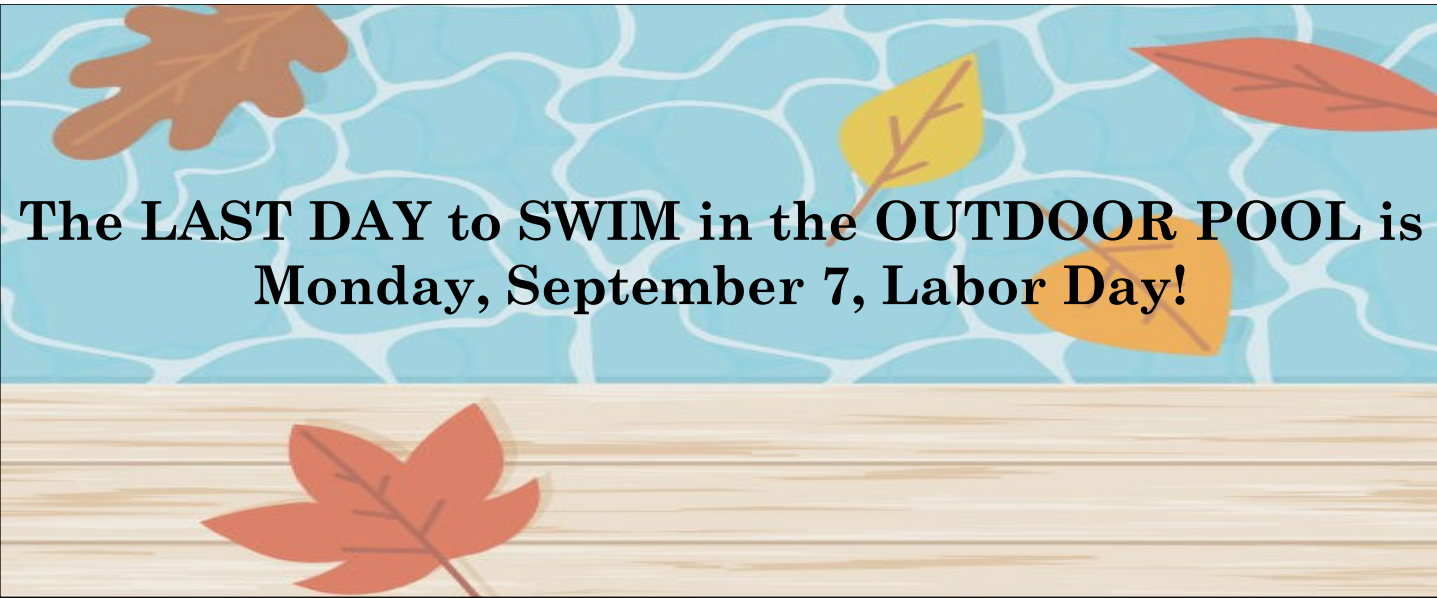
- **Monday–Thursday:** 9:00 AM–9:00 PM

A Few Important Reminders

- No lifeguard is on duty. Swim at your own risk, and please do not swim alone.
- Guests must be accompanied by an Owner or Occupant at all times.
- Children age 12 and under must be under an adult's direct supervision.
- Adult Lap and Adult Open Swim are for adults **18 years and older**.
- General Open Swim is the appropriate time for children to use the pool.
- Water Aerobics and organized water activities are for registered members.
- The hot tub is for adults **18 years and older**.

Thank you for respecting the schedule and helping ensure that **adults have dedicated times for lap swimming and exercise, while children have designated times to enjoy the pool as well.**

Outdoor Pool Deck Policy & Closing

The last day to swim in the outdoor pool is Monday, September 7. The Outdoor Pool Deck will remain open for resident use through Friday, October 16.

Pool deck access is only through the Lodge Activity Room and only during Lodge open hours. Residents may use the deck for lounging when no Lifeguard is present, provided the required signs are posted in accordance with county and state regulations. The pool and spa may not be used when a Lifeguard is not on duty, and all pool perimeter gates will remain locked.

Please follow all outdoor pool and Avenbury Lakes Rules and Regulations, including:

- Do not walk or sit on the pool or spa covers.
- Close umbrellas when finished lounging.

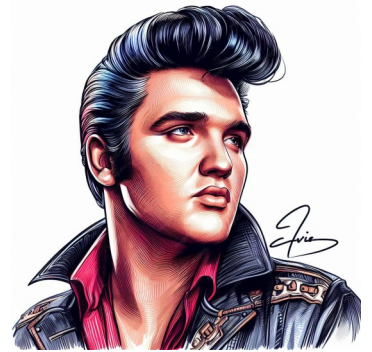
IT'S ABOUT THE MUSIC!

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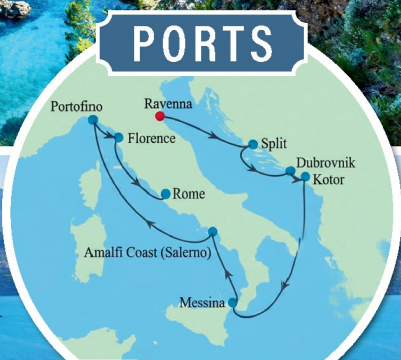
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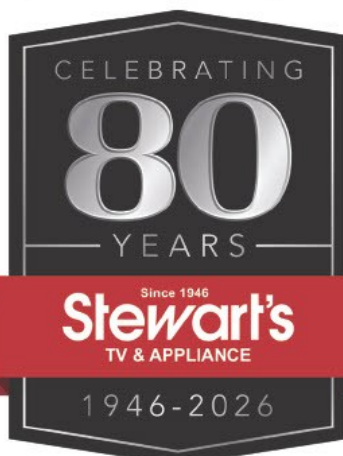

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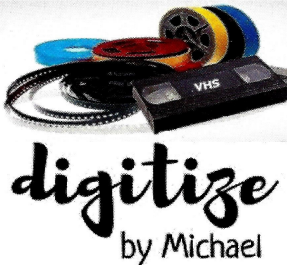
